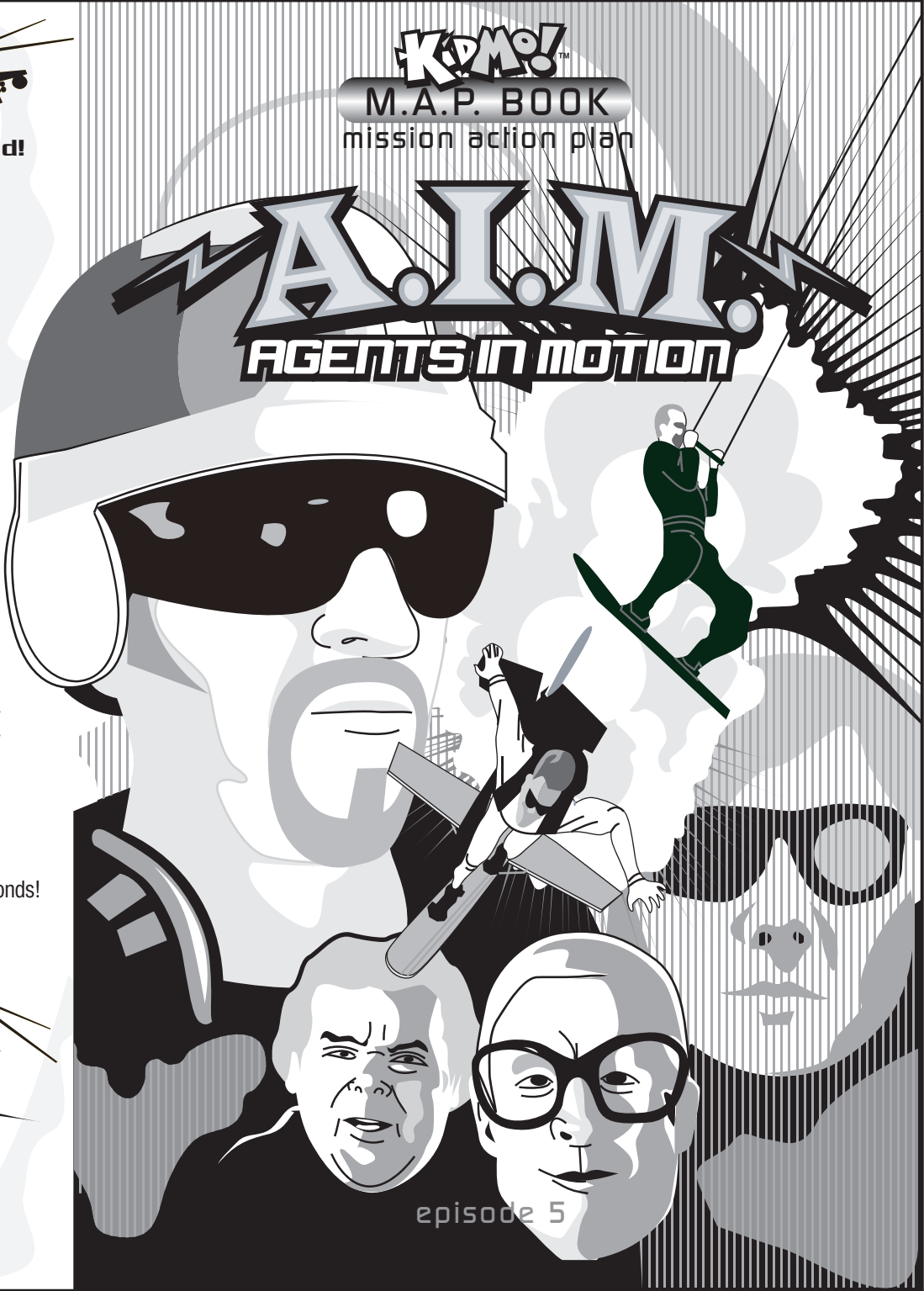

- bandaged his wounds

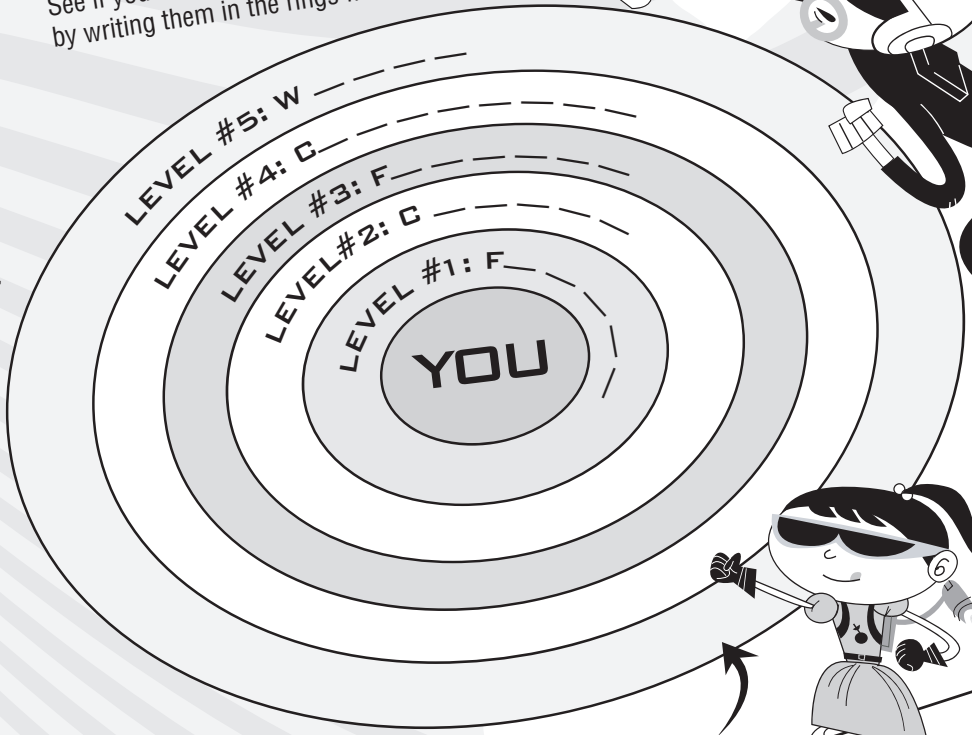
